Over the past 50 years, Clayton Church Homes (CCH) has become a significant provider of aged care in South Australia.

The organisation had its origins in the vision of two men, Jack Sinclair and Reverend Sydney Munn, both of whom were members of the Clayton Congregational Church at Beulah Park, Adelaide.

The opening of its first aged care facility in April 1968 was a bold beginning for the new organisation and its development since then has been far beyond what anyone could have predicted at the outset.

The growth of CCH mirrors the continuing growth and significance of the aged care industry in Australia.

Clayton Church Homes was officially incorporated on 23 March 1967 and in April of the same year, the first Board was appointed. All Board Members were members of Clayton Congregational Church and this remained the case until 1979.

## Home Care Services
